


Since the release of Juliann Kuchocki's debut full length album Don't Explain in April 2010, her album of original music Broken Compass in May 2012, and her latest release BLUE GIRL GREEN MARCH, 2013. Juliann has established record deals in four countries, won Best New Artist -Original Jazz Music at the 2011 Barrie Music Festival, opened the CMW jazz festival (with rave reviews), and has had Broken Compass programmed by over 150 radio stations world wide - reaching the top 10 in many countries, climbing up to #8 on Earshot National Jazz Chart; #25 on US Roots Music Report Jazz Chart; and #18 on the CMJ Chart.

BLUE GIRL GREEEN is Juliann's latest release featuring Blues standards as well as a couple of original tracks. Blue Girl Green, Broken Compass and Don't Explain all showcase Juliann's innate gifts and versatility. They are a celebration of a life's journey that has been by turns exciting and glamorous – yet also challenging and painful. Her own indomitable spirit and influences from great jazz, R&B, soul and pop artists past and present shine all the way through.

Juliann is the proud owner and director/ choreographer of Pro Arts triple-threat events company and school.
